World Sailing Youth World Championships (WSYWC)

General Details

BSA Role:	Team selection and qualification process
Spaces:	1 entry per event
Location:	Varies
Frequency:	Yearly
Time of Year:	Varies (generally in the “summer” of northern or southern hemispheres)
Equipment:	See the NoR for all events.

Eligibility

Bermudian Status:	National (WS 19.2)
Age:	Athletes shall be above the age of 12 years on the 1 st day of the event year, and under the age of 19 years on the last day of the event year.

** See the NoR to review all the eligibility requirements.

Qualification Period

The Qualification Period shall be between the REA Deadline and the Athlete Selection Date.

REA Deadline:	18 months prior to event
Athlete Selection Date:	14 days prior to the stated Entry Request Deadline in the NoR

Qualification Standards

1. To be eligible for selection, a minimum of 3 Qualification Events shall be completed by the athlete prior to the Selection Date.
2. If more than one athlete is competing for available spots, the Athlete Ranking system will be used. A total of the Athletes best three Qualification Event points from Qualification Events sailed within the Qualification Period will be used to rank the athletes.
3. At least one Qualification Event shall be BSA Graded **50** or higher and be included in the Athlete Ranking total.
4. The athlete must be in the top 50th percentile in at least one of the Qualification Events that is BSA Graded **50** or higher.

Any sailors interested in attending the WSYWC are encouraged to contact the BSA well in advance of the REA Deadline to help gain an understanding of the qualification process, expectations and assistance.
